Mexico City Policy reinstated by Pres. Trump

Longstanding principle prevents funding of abortion industry in other countries

Pro-life President Donald Trump today reinstated what is known as the Mexico City Policy. The policy withholds U.S. funds from organizations that promote or provide abortion in foreign countries, or that lobby foreign governments to legalize abortion.

“MCCL GO strongly supports President Trump’s decision to reinstate the Mexico City Policy,” said MCCL GO Executive Director Scott Fischbach. “Taxpayer dollars should not be used to kill innocent unborn children.”

The Mexico City Policy was instituted by pro-life President Ronald Reagan in 1984. It was rescinded by President Bill Clinton, reinstated by President George W. Bush, and blocked again by President Barack Obama.

“Destroying the lives of unborn babies, and encouraging individuals and nations to do so, is not the role of the U.S. government,” Fischbach added.
