MCCL GO receives accreditation from Organization of American States

New status offers more opportunity to share life-affirming message

Minnesota Citizens Concerned for Life Global Outreach (MCCL GO) received official notification this week of approval to be included as a registered civil society organization in the Organization of American States (OAS). According to a letter dated June 8, the accreditation came from action taken by the Permanent Council on June 3, 2015.

“We are pleased and excited at this new opportunity to share our life-affirming message with the 35 member nations that comprise the OAS,” stated Scott Fischbach, Executive Director of the Global Outreach program of Minnesota Citizens Concerned for Life.

MCCL GO will take its place on the roster with 424 other civil society organizations that currently counsel and advise the 35 member nations. MCCL GO also has consultative status with the United Nations Economic and Social Council. “The MCCL message of full human rights for all human beings has been received very well at the United Nations and we hope for the same at the OAS,” commented Fischbach.

In addition to providing counsel and advice to member nations at the UN and the OAS, MCCL GO provides research and analysis on issues affecting the full life-course to delegates and ambassadors. The issues of abortion, infanticide and euthanasia are always present at all levels of government.
